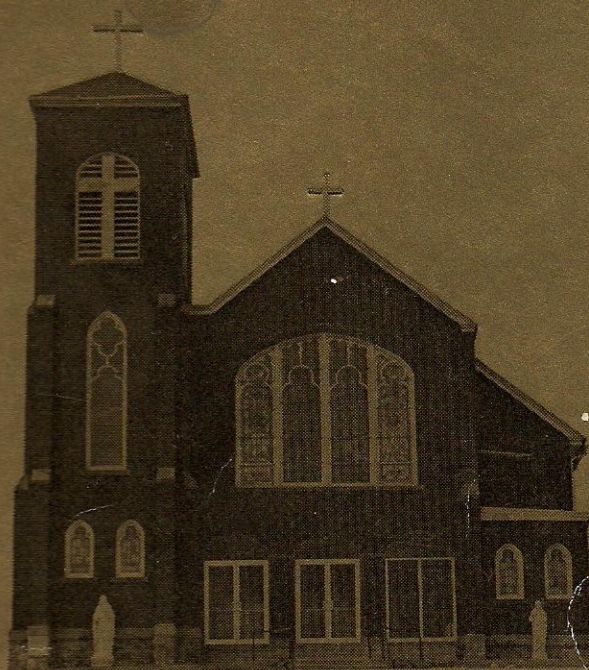

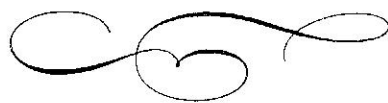

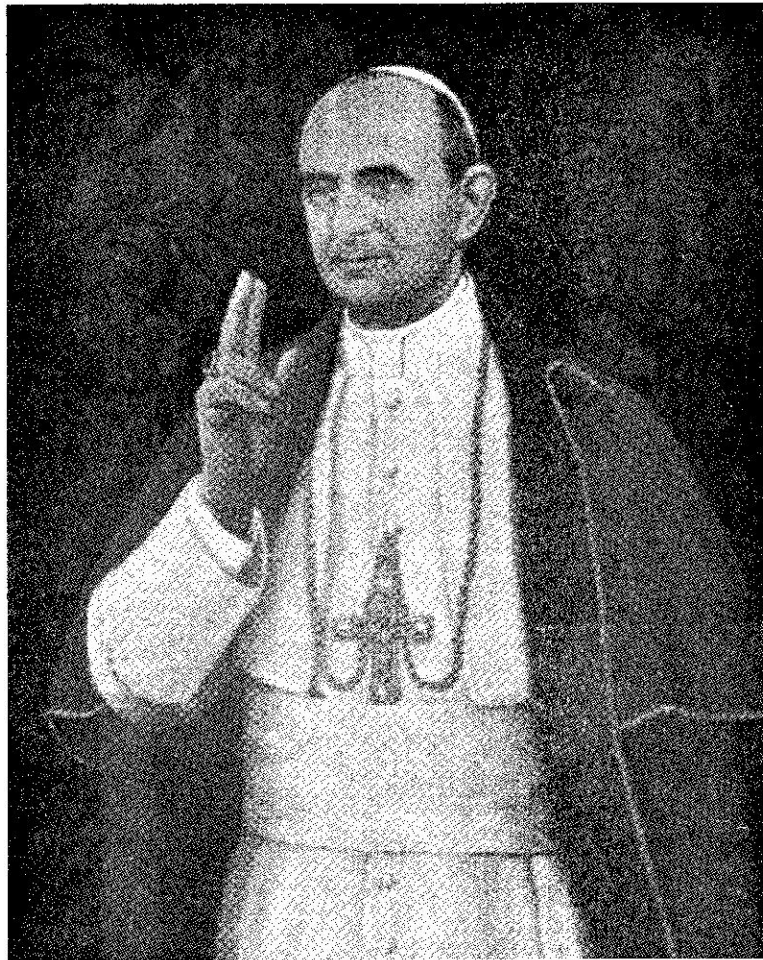

I gladly grant the permission you request to offer a Solemn Mass on that date at 4:00 P.M.

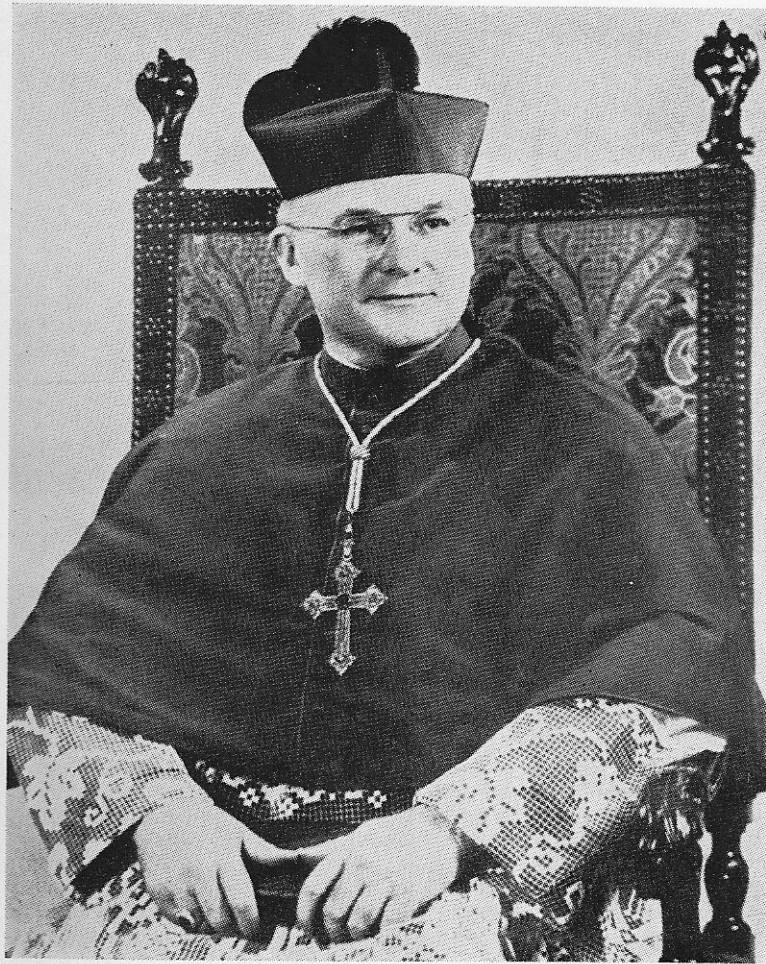

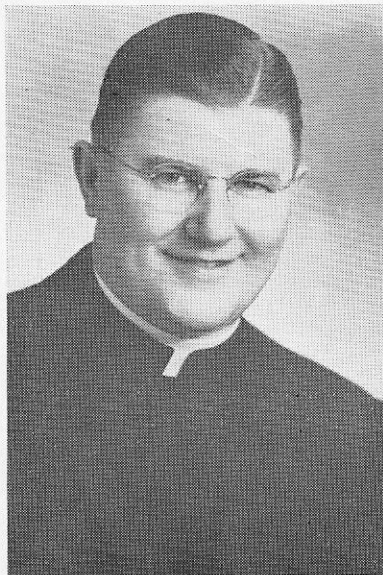

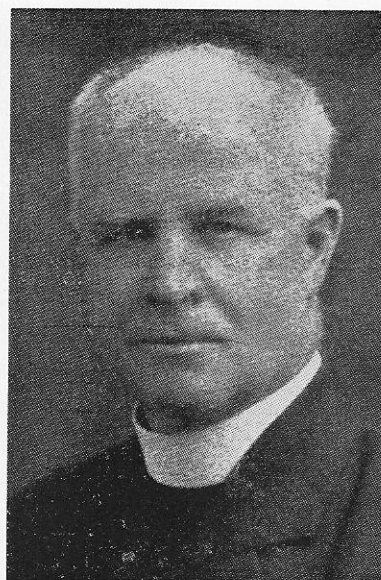

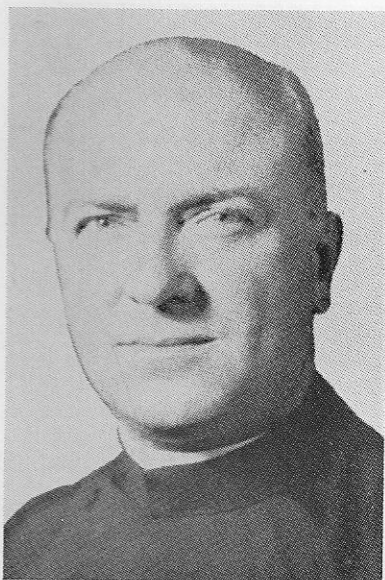

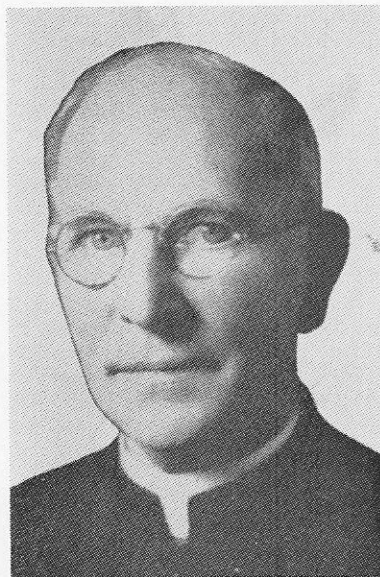

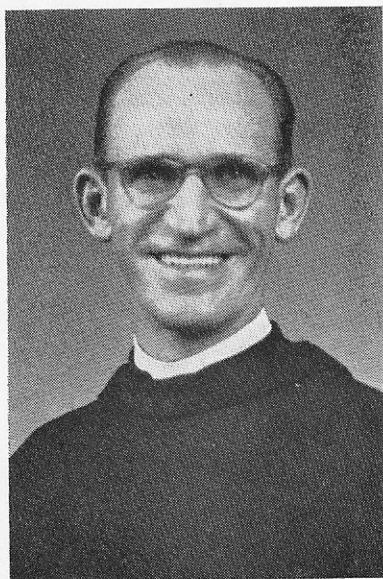

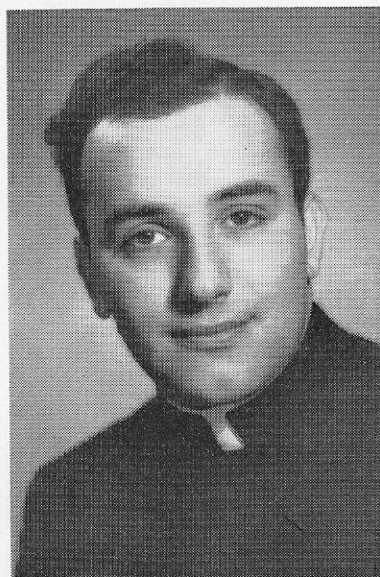

Father Stephen J. Gergel was born in Mount Union, Pa., son of Michael and Agnes Kuflek Gergel. He received his primary and secondary education in Mt. Union. He finished his college and seminary education at St. Francis in Loretto, Pa., and was ordained in May of 1962. He is now Assistant Pastor at Our Lady Victory Church in State College, Pa.

A BRIEF HISTORY of ST. CATHERINE OF SIENNA CHURCH

Religious Services were held at various times as early as 1848 in the home of John Dougherty. The Reverend John Walsh was one of the first priests that we know to celebrate Mass in the Dougherty home. After him came many other priests:

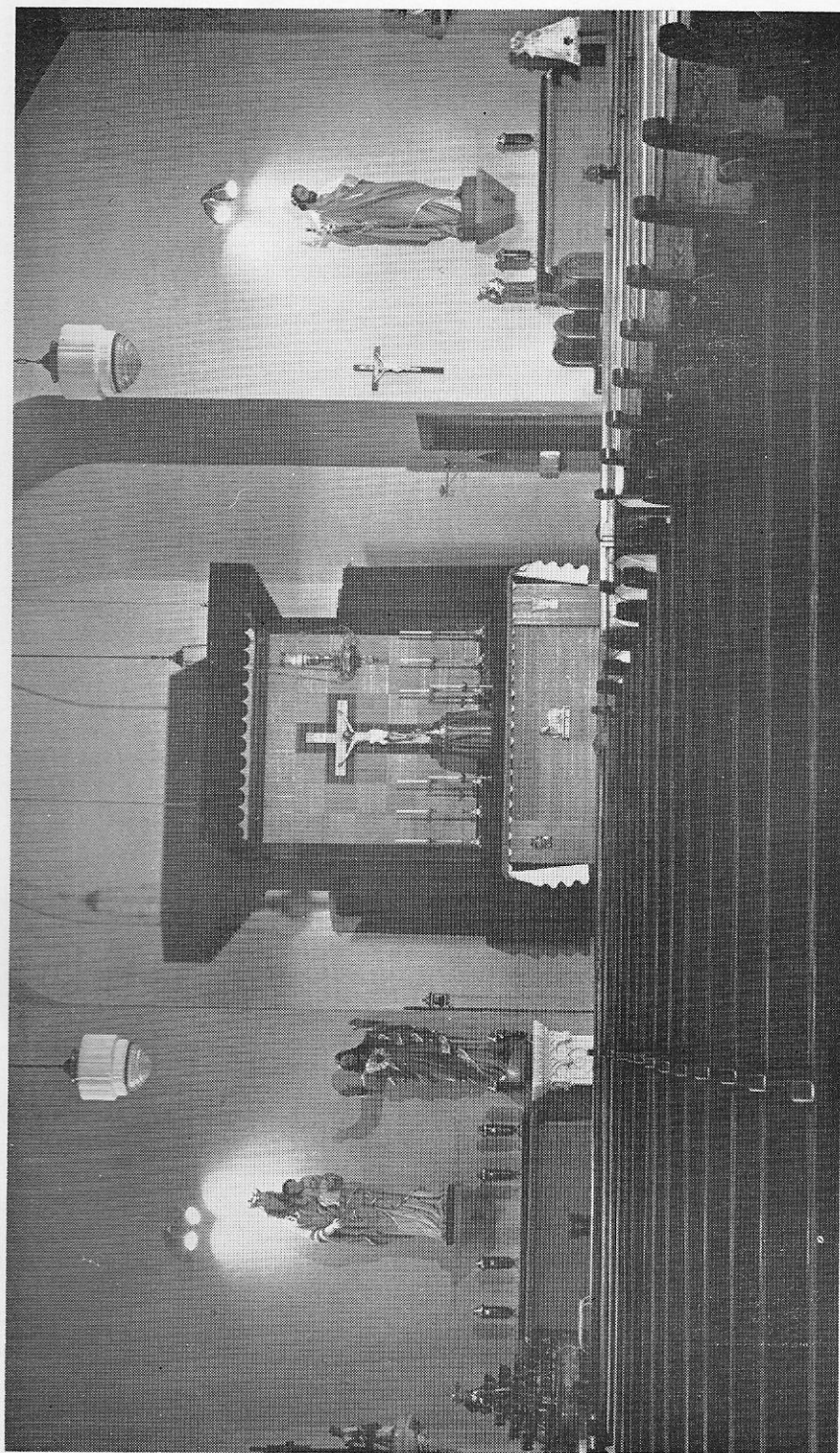
The Reverend Fathers: Peter M. Doyle, 1851-1861; Peter Hughes, 1861-1863; Stephen Wall, 1863-1865; Owen P. Gallagher, 1865-1870; Patrick B. Halloran, 1870-1871; Martin Murphy, 1871-1878; Arthur Devlin, 1879-1881; Louis M. Woelfel, 1882-1888; James I. McDonnell, 1889-1891; Thomas Walsh, 1891-1892; William P. Dunlea, 1892; Florence F. O'Shea, 1892; Patrick Hawe, 1892-1896; David J. Walsh, 1896-1900; Thomas J. Conlin, 1900-1901; Peter Fox, 1901-1903; James A. Keeney, 1904-1906; Jerome L. McQuillen, 1906-1910; John L. O'Donnell, 1910-1912; James A. Tolan, 1912-1921.

The Most Reverend Eugene Garvey, D. D., first Bishop of the Altoona Diocese, gave permission to Father Tolan, Pastor of Holy Trinity Church in Huntingdon, to build a church in Mount Union, Pa.

On September 2, 1912, the contract for the new church (\$8,630.10) was given to T. C. Peduzzi. The architect was J. Herbert Hall. The church was constructed of red brick and a slate roof. Excavation was done by Henry and Samuel McGarvey. The three altars were a donation from St. Matthew's Church in Tyrone through the Cullen Family. The bell was donated by Patrick Geraghty and named in honor of St. Patrick. The stained glass windows and statues were donated by parishioners or societies. Bishop Garvey laid the cornerstone in the Fall of 1912. On Sunday, August 31, 1913, the new church was blessed and dedicated by Bishop Garvey in the presence of some 500 Priests and people. The church continued as a Mission from Huntingdon.

The records from Huntingdon show that in the new church: the first Marriage was that of Fred Dughi and Theresa Peduzzi, September 10, 1913; the first Baptism was that of Leonardo Bellucci, September 28, 1913; the first Funeral was that of Edward Adiutori, March 25, 1914.

John Dougherty with his wife Catherine (McElheny) and their children: Edward, Mary, Theodore, Eugene, Victoria, Victor and Gerald came to this vicinity. John Dougherty was a staunch Catholic and a man of progress and charity. At one time, he owned most of the land west of Division Street. With a George W. Speer, he was instrumental in laying out Mount Union, 1846, getting a charter, 1867, and in naming many of the streets. Religious Services were held in his home until the new church was built. The first three Pastors lived in his home until the present rectory was built.

John Dougherty donated the large tract of land on which the church, rectory, school and park are located.

Some of the members of the Building Committee were Andrew Bodnar, Henry and Samuel McGarvey. Andrew Bodnar was also the first organist, his brother, John, served as an altar boy and sexton, another brother, Stephen, later became the organist, and the last brother, Michael, was in the choir. The McGarvey family worked zealously for the new church, especially Henry, Samuel and Annavesta. Annavesta McGarvey worked devoutly for the welfare of the church until her death in 1957. The descendants of the Bodnar and McGarvey families are still active in church affairs.

St. Catherine of Sienna Church became a Parish, July 1, 1921, and St. Mary's Church in Shade Valley became its Mission until June 7, 1962.

The Reverend Michael E. Zamba was appointed the first Pastor, July 1, 1921. The Reverend Thomas O'Donnell succeeded him as the second Pastor July 6, 1922 to November 14, 1922. Both these Pastors worked zealously during their short time here.

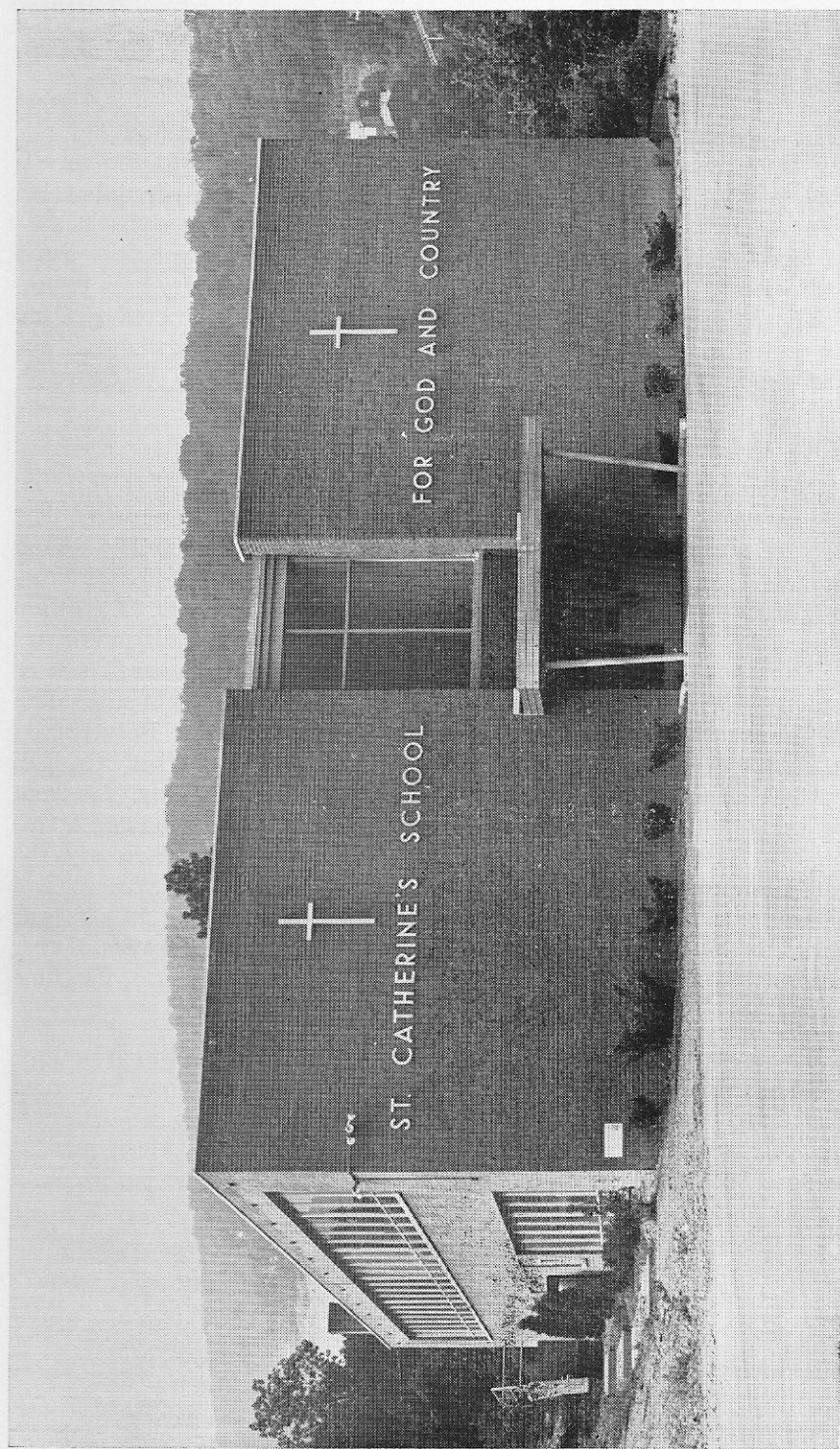
The Reverend John A. Kerkoska became the third Pastor, November 14, 1922. During his pastorate, many improvements were made. The debt was paid off. The present rectory was built (\$10,752.17) in 1925. The church grounds were graded, a Grecian retaining wall constructed, steps and railings leading up to the church and rectory and sidewalks around the property put in, the grounds were terraced and sodded. A Cemetery of three acres in Shirleysburg was acquired and Blessed. The church was repaired in 1934.

After the death of Father Kerkoska in 1945, the parish was administered for a time by the Reverend Alphonsus Sobota, T. O. R., who continued the good work.



The Reverend Joseph M. Rusnak became the fourth Pastor, January 22, 1943. During his pastorate, the debt was paid off. The Taylor property on the corner of Washington and Market Streets was purchased and remodeled for the present Convent. Sisters of the Mission Helpers of the Sacred Heart occupied the Convent for the first time. They did Catechetical work and took an annual census of the parish. The Reverend John V. Orlando was appointed the

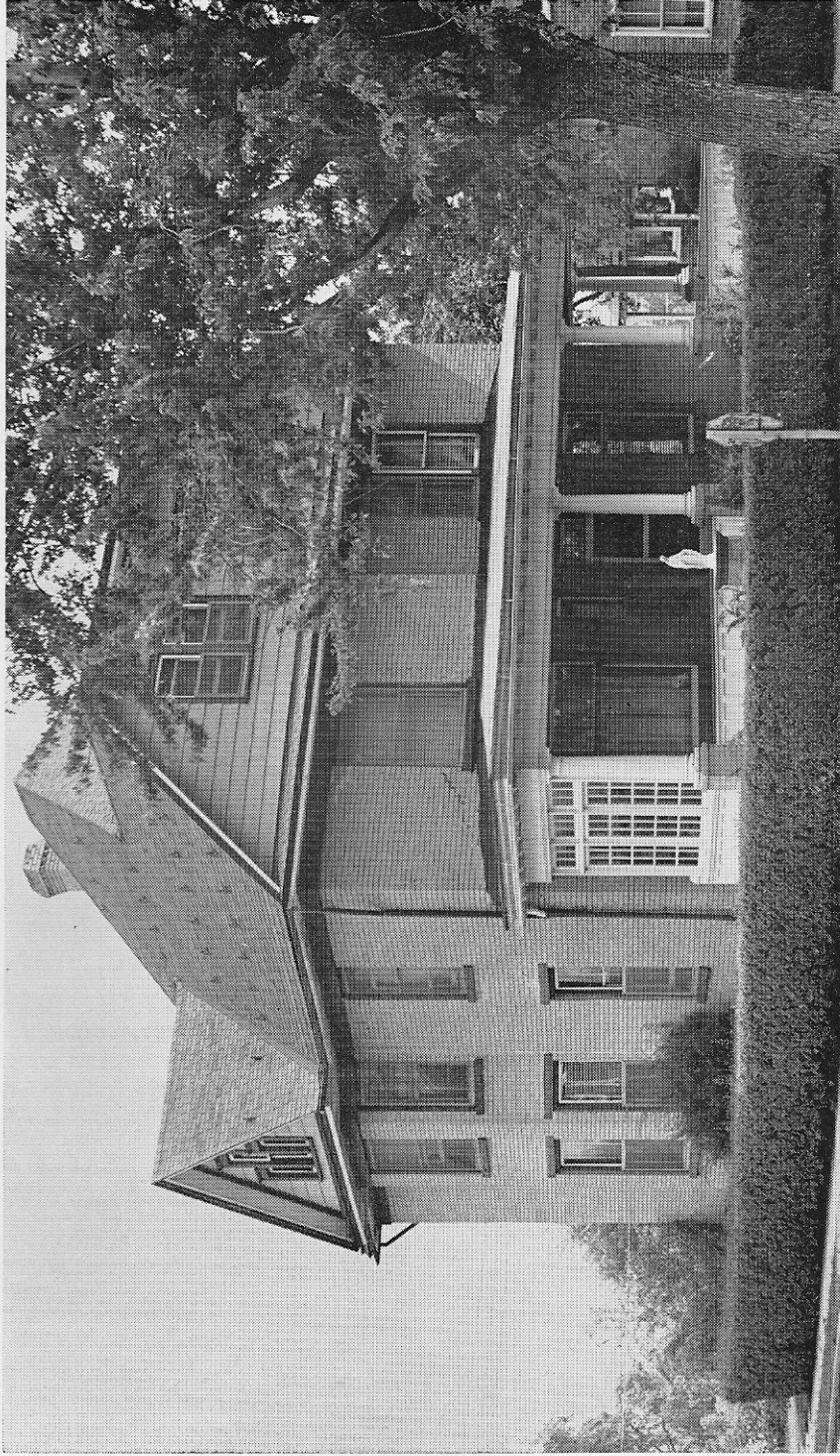
St. Catherine of Sienna Parochial School

first Assistant Pastor, June, 1951. The Reverend George Grega succeeded him as Assistant Pastor June, 1952, and remained in charge after Father Rusnak died October 25, 1952.

The Reverend John B. Golias was appointed fifth Pastor July, 1953. During his pastorate, many improvements were also made to the church properties. A new Pipe Organ was installed and dedicated November 14, 1954, new kneelers put in the church, a new drive-way and side-walks around the church, the Cemetery reseeded in grass. The new School Fund was increased to a point where construction was seen in the very near future. Church Societies were revitalized. Attendance at Mass and reception of the Sacraments was notably increased. The Reverend John A. Halka was appointed Assistant Pastor in May of 1954, a position he held until June 7, 1962. Father Golias was transferred to Pastor of St. John the Baptist, Central City, Pa., May, 1958.

The Reverend Gerard J. Oeler became the sixth Pastor May 1, 1958. During his pastorate, a cherished dream of the parish became a reality. The first Catholic School in Huntingdon County was built (\$140,000.00); ground was broken March 4, 1959, the new School was blessed and dedicated October 18, 1959 by the Most Reverend Howard Joseph Carroll, D. D., Bishop of Altoona-Johnstown, in the presence of the Parishioners, Friends and Priests of the Diocese. The school opened August 31, 1959, with an enrollment of 45 students in the first four grades; grades 5 and 6 were added in succeeding years when enrollment reached 85 students. The Sisters of the Holy Family of Nazareth staffed the new school. Sister M. Marcella was the first Principal. A new Sacristy with new equipment was added to the old Sacristy. The front of the church was enclosed with modern glass doors, thereby, making a vestibule. The three altars were renovated, a new roof put on the rectory, the convent repainted and new lighting fixtures installed. External woodwork of the church was painted. A new drive-way and parking lot for 58 cars was constructed. The School Fund Drive netted \$55,000.00 in three years. Father Oeler was transferred to Pastor of St. Joseph Church in Renovo, Pa. June 7, 1962.

The Reverend Joseph D. Tomko was appointed the seventh Pastor June 7, 1962. Some of the debt has been paid off. The church windows have been renovated and new storm windows installed. A new school bus has been purchased. A new roof on the church has been contracted for. Much remains to be done both for the spiritual and temporal welfare of the parish. With trust in God, our parish can be one of the very best.
