Stewardship Reflection: In contemplating the stunning power show of Jesus’ power in feeding the crowd of thousands with five loaves and two fish (and some left over) it is easy to overlook an important detail for us Christian stewards. When the apostles suggest to Jesus that He should dismiss the hungry crowd so they could go and find some dinner, Jesus had another idea. “Give them some food yourselves,” He tells them. This seemed impossible and would take great effort. Jesus is not asking the impossible, He is asking us to give Him what we do have for the sake of others and let Him do the impossible with it. This is the essence of the stewardship way of life. The sharing of ourselves and our gifts does not leave us with less, but with more. The faith community in today’s Gospel ended up with a surplus after everyone shared their gifts in Jesus, name. May we trust that we will always have enough because we have decided to be good stewards expecting nothing in return.
