The Bob Perks Cancer Assistance Fund (BPF) helps ease the financial burden of individuals and families in our community who are battling cancer by providing funding for basic necessities (rent, utilities, gas & grocery cards, etc.) so their focus is on treatment and recovery. The organization supports individuals living in Bedford, Blair, Centre, Clearfield, Huntingdon, Mifflin, and Juniata Counties. Qualified applicants can receive up to \$1,000 every 90 days, and are referred by their oncology team. In 2024, BPF allocated nearly \$367,000 to 464 local cancer patients and their families. All funds raised stay in our local communities.

Next week we will take up the Peter's Pence Collection to support the Universal Church and the work of the Holy See, including the charitable works of Pope Francis. These works benefit our brothers and sisters on the margins of society, including victims of war, oppression, and disasters. Please be generous.
