<u>Stewardship Reflections</u> March 10, 2024 4th Sunday of Lent

Our readings today remind us that Jesus came into the world, suffered, and died for each one of us. It is a profound truth that we often forget through the busyness of life. Jesus came for you.

We must realize that it was not out good works on our part that He did this for us, but out of pure love. When

we recognize that His love does not waver in any circumstance, we become overwhelmed with gratitude. How can we respond to this? Marian Devotions:


Approximately 30 minutes before each Mass begins with the recitation of the Holy Rosary.
