The organization covers patients living in seven local counties, including Huntingdon. In 2025, BPF allocated nearly \$64,000 to 83 cancer patients living in Huntingdon County alone. All funds raised stay local to help our friends and neighbors. We are proud to say that last year’s sale raised a new record of more than \$8,000. With your help, we hope to surpass that record again this year!
